



## **Press Release**

After approximately 10 years in the planning, permitting, and regulatory process, and 1 additional year in construction at the Lime Saddle Marina area and along Pentz Road, **Del Oro Water Company has completed the Regional Intertie Project.** The Regional Intertie provides an independent and increased water supply from Lake Oroville to Del Oro's Upper Ridge Districts' customers. As of June 12, Lime Saddle District is receiving 100% of its water from Lake Oroville. Water that was previously imported to Lime Saddle from Del Oro's Stirling Bluffs District, via Paradise Irrigation District, is now available for exclusive use in its Magalia and Paradise Pines Districts. The new Regional Intertie also is designed to allow water to be transported throughout the ridge area in case of emergencies.

The completed project includes:

- 2.5 miles 16" pipeline
- New lake intake system, including sinking two 20-inch pipes 636 feet down into the lake
- Expansion of the treatment plant
- Construction of a Mid Zone Booster Station and 350,000 gallon storage tank
- Modification the Upper Zone Pumping Plant
